Demographic Perspective

- 2,883,850 IL women 13-44 years old
- 1,561,720 IL women 13-44 years old need contraceptive services and supplies
- 684,630 IL Women in Need (WIN)
 - Alan Guttmacher Institute Data


Definition of WIN

- Women in need of publicly supported contraceptive services and supplies includes
 - Women <20 in need of contraceptive services
 - Women 20-44 who are under 250% of poverty and in need




Number of women served in Title X clinics

- CY07 – 131,214 women served
- 94.8% live at 200% of poverty or less
- 33.0% received services paid by Medicaid
- 35.2% is a very conservative estimate of women that should have been enrolled in IHW



IHW Benefits > Title X

- Reimbursement for oral contraceptives is higher
- Reimbursement for HIV testing
- Reimbursement for mammograms
- Reimbursement for sterilization
- Reimbursement for multivitamins and folic acid

- Adolescents and older women seeking confidential services
- Undocumented clients
- Males
